NASA HAS GOT A PROBLEM

NASA moon bombing violates space law and may cause conflict NASA:LCROSS bombing of the moon is planned for October 9 2009 so a report states. A NASA orbiter will bomb the moon with a 2-ton kinetic weapon to create a 5 mile wide deep crater as an alleged water-seeking and lunar colonization experiment, it is contrary to space law prohibiting environmental modification of celestial bodies. The NASA moon bombing, is component of the LCROSS mission, may also trigger conflict with known extraterrestrial civilization on the moon as reported in witnessed statements by U.S. astronauts Buzz Aldrin and Neil Armstrong In these witnessed statements to NSA (National Security Agency) photos and documents regarding an extraterrestrial base on the dark side of the moon are disclosed.

If it is the true intent of the LCROSS mission moon bombing then it is a hostile act by NASA against known extraterrestrial civilizations and settlements on the moon which is a breach of the UN charter and the Geneva Conventions to which the US is subject.

The UN Outer Space Treaty requires that "The moon and other celestial bodies shall be used by all States Parties to the Treaty exclusively for peaceful purposes. The establishment of military bases, installations and fortifications, the testing of any type of weapons and the conduct of military manoeuvres on celestial bodies shall be forbidden." 98 nations have ratified and 125 nations have signed the U.N. Outer Space Treaty.

LCROSS (Lunar Crater Observation and Sensing Satellite) mission, departed back in June. According to one report, "Flying over the moon's southern hemisphere LCROSS will use its high precision instruments, as well as

close-up images of the terrain gather by the lunar orbiter, to seek out a crater just shallow enough and dark enough to target bomb. The alleged reason: to probe landing sites and search for water sources that could be used by a future lunar colony.

THE PINEAL GLAND - LOOKS LIKE A PINE CONE

The pineal gland is located near to the center of the brain, between the two hemispheres, tucked in a groove where the two rounded thalamic bodies join. Unlike much of the rest of the brain, the pineal gland is not isolated from the body by the blood-brain barrier system.

It is reddish-gray and about the size of a pea (8 mm in humans), located just rostro-dorsal to the superior colliculus and behind and beneath the stria medullaris, between the laterally positioned thalamic bodies. It is part of the epithalamus. It is a midline structure, and is often seen in plain skull X-rays, as it is often calcified. Calcification is typically due to intake of the fluoride found in water and toothpaste. It was the last endocrine gland to have its function discovered.

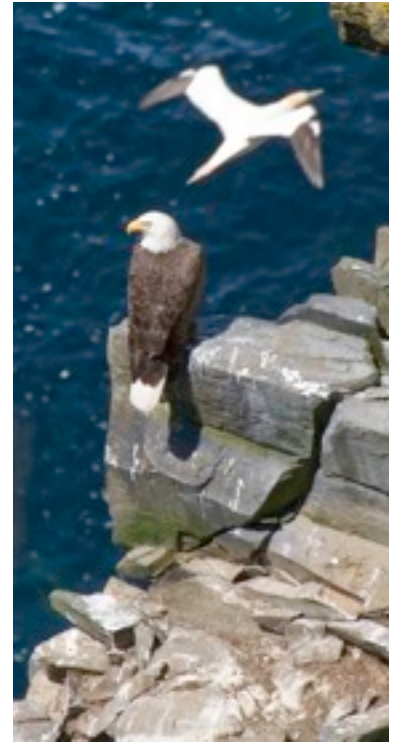
